DRIVER RECORD MONITORING

Driver Record Monitoring manages individual driving record data, automatically checking for new violations, DUI or DWI convictions, license suspensions, cancellations, and approaching license renewal dates. Each month, a concise report identifies new incidents and alerts management to the most critical fleet issues. In addition, high-risk drivers can be quickly scheduled for the appropriate online driver training class.

- Integrates report statistics into the dashboard and provides timely Alerts.
